Labor Day

Labor Day is held on the first Monday in September, and is a national annual tribute to the contributions workers have made to the strength, prosperity, and well-being of our country.

The first Labor Day was celebrated on Tuesday, September 5, 1882, in New York City per request of the Central Labor Union. In 1884 the first Monday in September was selected as the holiday, and the Central Labor Union urged similar organizations to celebrate a "workingmen's holiday" on that date. 10 years later in 1894, the U.S. Congress voted to approve Labor Day as a national holiday, and President Grover Cleveland signed it into law.

Patriot Day and National Day of Service and Remembrance

In honor of all those who lost their lives during the terrorist attacks on September 11, 2001, President George W. Bush declared September 11 to be known as Patriot Day.

In September 2012, President Barack Obama issued a proclamation renaming the day to Patriot Day and National Day of Service and Remembrance. President Obama stated that the flag should be flown at half-staff on Patriot Day and National Day of Remembrance, and that a moment of silence should be observed beginning at 8:46 am, the time of which the first plane struck the North Tower of the World Trade Center.

Recycling Clarifications

WRC Senior Services would like to thank everyone for their participation in the Villages voluntary recycling program. We would like to make a few necessary clarifications:

- ◇ Only bottles numbered 1 & 2 (any bottle with the opening smaller than the container) i.e. water bottles, laundry soap bottles, dish soap bottles. Must:
 - ◆ Be rinsed
 - ◆ No lids
 - ◆ Crushed, if possible. This enables us to fit more in the recycling container
- ◇ Plastic recycling does **NOT** include:
 - ◆ Clamshell containers— see photos below— berries, cookies, take out foods etc. containers
 - ◆ No plastic bags of any kind.

Giant Eagle & Mike's both have a drop off for plastic bags located outside the stores near the entrance for you to drop off your plastic bags.
