A memorial donation is a charitable gift made in honor of a person who has passed away. It's easy to make a donation to WRC Senior Services.

When you make a gift in memory of a loved one, you give to a WRC Senior in need.

What is charitable care at WRC and how will your gift benefit another senior? Charity care is healthcare provided for free or at reduced cost for low income residents. By naming a memorial for your loved one, you will be helping another resident.

Can I include WRC as a memorial gift recipient in an obituary?

Yes. An obituary for someone you love is an important way to honor and celebrate life. WRC Senior Services may have been important to your loved one or perhaps the family would like to "pay it forward" by asking for donations for WRC to help with other seniors. The family may wish to have people donate to a memorial fund. For any donation request, include WRC Senior Services name and community of choice as well as an address or website where people can send donations.

If the family prefers a charitable donation, include a phrase such as "In lieu of flowers," followed by "please consider a donation to WRC Senior Services."
