RESIDENT SPOTLIGHT

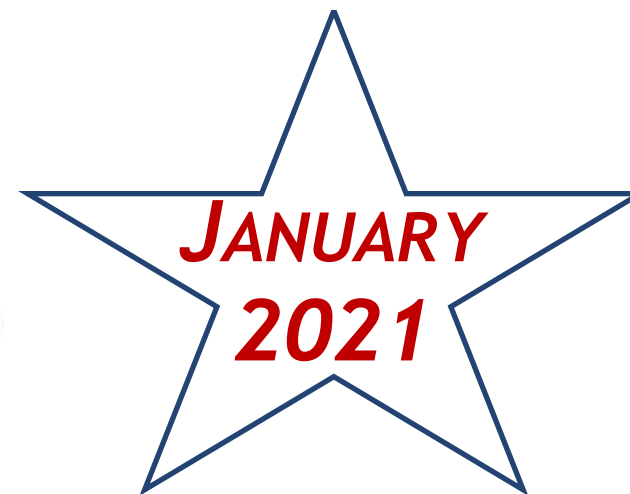
SHIRLEY PENCE
