### **RESIDENT SPOTLIGHT STELLA WOODS**





Stella loves to garden and has beautiful plants in her apartment, especially African Violets.

An avid bird watcher, Stella will share her knowledge of Native Pennsylvania birds, proper feed/bird seed and weather patterns that affect birds migration and locations at specific times. Crows are known to warn of danger, alert animals and birds. Starlings are a nuisance bird brought in from Europe. Hummingbirds are beautiful to watch, colorful, and territorial. Catbirds will mimic the songs of other birds.

Stella has cataloged the following birds since arriving at NFH: Woodpeckers (Downey, hairy, & red bellied), sparrows, cardinals, black spotted starlings, nuthatch (moves upside down on tree), blue jays, titmouse (looks like miniature female cardinal), crows, doves, and hawks.

These birds return in Spring: turkey vulture, pewee, robins, bluebirds, wren, hummingbirds, red-winged blackbird, grackle (black/purple), cowbird, goldfinch (males-yellow with black wings & head).

If you spend time observing the birds at the feeders, please consider a contribution of bird seed. It would be greatly appreciated.

Stella Woods grew up in North Freedom, Pennsylvania, Armstrong County, and lived with her family on the original homestead. She can date the homestead back to her great, great grandfather.
