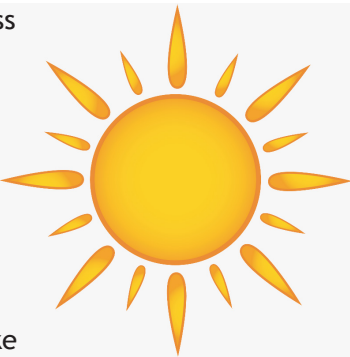
**Monthly Poem** shared by Judy Schwab, Village tenant.
