- -The first American Heart Month, which took place in February 1964, was proclaimed by President Lyndon B. Johnson via Proclamation 3566 on December 30, 1963.
- -The Congress, by joint resolution on that date, has requested the President to issue annually a proclamation designating February as American Heart Month.
- -While American Heart Month is a federally designated month in the United States, it's important to realize that cardiovascular disease knows no borders.
