



WRC Visitation Guidelines:

Visitation can be conducted through different means based on each facility's structure and residents' needs, such as in resident rooms, dedicated visitation spaces, and outdoors. Residents are permitted to leave the Facility for scheduled visits. All visitors are required to comply with core principles of infection prevention to reduce risk of COVID-19 transmission.

Core Principles of COVID-19 Infection Prevention

- Visitors who have a positive viral test for COVID-19, symptoms of COVID-19, or currently meet the criteria for quarantine, will not be permitted to visit the building. Visitors will be screened for COVID -19 prior to each visit.
- Hand hygiene is required at entry of building. (Use of alcohol-based hand rub is preferred)
- Face covering or mask (covering mouth and nose) and physical distancing at least six feet between people, in accordance with CDC guidance. (The face coverings, gowns, N95, face shields and goggles will no longer be provided.)
- The Visitor must provide their own PPE (Personal Protective Equipment), or kits will be available for purchase.

Separate COVID-19 care areas may require visitor to wear accordingly:

- Green Zone: non fabric surgical mask required
 - Yellow Zone: N95, isolation gown, goggles or face shield
 - Red Zone: N95, isolation gown, goggles or face shield
- Instructional signage and education throughout the facility must be followed.
 - During indoor visitation, visitor movement is limited to resident designated visitation space only.
 - Visitors must acknowledge that it is safer not to enter facility during outbreak, and the risk of exposure to COVID-19 transmission is present.

Please contact the Facility Administrator with any questions, concerns or to schedule a visit. It is preferred but not required to schedule facility visits.
